Information in accordance with FCC 47 CFR §20.19

Overview

We are committed to providing wireless devices that are accessible to individuals who use hearing aids and cochlear implants. In compliance with FCC requirements, we provide Hearing Aid Compatibility (HAC) ratings for our devices.

Hearing Aid Compatibility (HAC) ratings help consumers understand how well a wireless device works with hearing aids.

Devices are rated for:

- **M-Rating (Microphone Mode):** Measures RF interference
- **T-Rating (Telecoil Mode):** Measures inductive coupling performance

Ratings range from **M1 to M4** and **T1 to T4**, with higher numbers indicating better performance.

Compatibility Requirements

FCC rules require service providers to offer a minimum number of HAC-compatible devices.

A device is considered HAC-compatible if it is rated at least:

- **M3** for acoustic coupling
- **T3** for inductive coupling
